

Mrs. Art Rugg To Be Buried Here Monday

Mrs. Winnie J. Rugg, former Wheatland resident, passed away Wed., Dec. 9 at Mesa, Ariz., at the age of 83, following an extended illness. The deceased was born April 22, 1887 at Kearney, Nebr. and was married on Nov. 20, 1906 at Kearney to Arthur Rugg.

Mrs. Rugg had made her home at Cheyenne Bear Creek Ranch and in Wheatland from 1913 to 1960, and for the past ten years had resided in Florida and Arizona. She was a member of the PEO Sisterhood, Chapter R, and was affiliated with the Christian Science organization.
