

RUMSEY, GEORGIA MILLER

March 4, 1911-April 21, 1998

Services for Georgia M. Rumsey, 87, were held Saturday, APRIL 28, 1998, at 10:30 a.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Reverend Delbert Dick of the American Missionary Fellowship officiating.

Mrs. Rumsey, a long time Wheatland resident, died Tuesday, April 21, 1998 at the Boise Samaritan Nursing Home in Boise, Idaho.

Georgia was born April 21, 1911, in Marysville, MO, the daughter of Bert Marion and Agnes Mae (Dougan) Miller. When she was three years old, the family moved to Chugwater, Wyo., and lived in that area until 1927 when the family moved to Wheatland. Her dad worked for the Swan Company on the Bard Ranch. She met Frank Rumsey, and they were married in 1930 and lived in Wheatland. Georgia moved to Boise, Idaho, to be near family.
