

PEARL RUMSEY

September 29, 1905-February 4, 1988

Services for Pearl Rumsey, 83, who died in Wheatland Feb. 4, 1988, were held Monday, Feb. 8, 1988, at 10 a.m. at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Reverend Gene Hagerman officiating.

Born Sept. 29, 1905 in Fullerton, Neb., she was the daughter of Edward Lewis and Margaret Lillian (Sample) Rumsey. As a young child, she moved with her family to Wheatland where she attended schools and graduated from Wheatland High School.

Pearl will be remembered by many area residents because she had numerous jobs dealing with the public. She worked as a telephone operator, as a secretary at Wheatland High School, Head Start at Guernsey and at the Platte Co. Extension Office.
