

**MRS. JOS RUTHERFORD DIES**

Mrs. Joseph Rutherford died at her home in Wheatland Friday morning following a long illness. Nannie Lane was born some 61 years ago, and has resided in this section of Wyoming for the past thirty-five or more years. She was married to Joseph Rutherford in the early days of the colony and to them was born one son, whose death some three years ago saddened their lives beyond consolation. They sold their ranch on Cottonwood with its poignant memories and moved to town two years ago.

Mrs. Rutherford had never been a well woman and grief hastened the end. She is survived by her husband, her brother, Will Lane, and a brother, M Lane, who came here recently from the east to visit her. Mrs. Rutherford had always been a very quiet home making woman whose friends were those of a lifetime.

The funeral was held from the Methodist church on Monday afternoon, with Rev. O. C. King delivering the funeral address, and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson Mortuary in charge of arrangements.
