

Bessie Tachovsky dies in Douglas

Born in Wilbur, Nebr. to Anna and Lawrence Swoboda, Mrs. Bessie Tachovsky died Feb. 15, 1963 at the age of 84, in Douglas after a brief illness. She had been a resident of Wheatland for the past fifteen years, and was preceded in death by her husband, Frank Tachovsky in November, 1962.
