UNKNOWN BABY ?-June 19, 1916

The body of a new-born baby girl was found wedged among floating debris at the footbridge at the Wyoming Development company's ditch just south of the hospital Monday evening.

It was discovered by children playing along the bank, who told E.M. Havens of their find, he in turn notifying Deputy Sheriff Edwards.

The body was absolutely without covering of any description, and was badly decomposed, evidently having been in the water several days.

Coroner Corry was summoned from Chugwater and impaneled a jury on Tuesday, which returned a verdict stating the child had come to its death at the hands of its parents.

Sheriff Roach is working hard on the case and hopes for a speedy solution of the puzzle that will lead to the arrest of the guilty parties.
