3-7 LOLA MAE DANNAR WALLEY 1986

Services for Lola Mae Walley, 59, who died March 7 in Beaumont, Texas were held Wednesday at 2:00 P.M. in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Father Kale King officiating.

Born in Wheatland July 23, 1926, Lola Mae was the daughter of Ralph C. and Violet Mickle Dannar. She was raised here and graduated from Wheatland High School in 1944. After graduating she moved to Denver and was associated with J.C. Penney Stores.

She and Lesley Walley were married in Wheatland, Aug. 17, 1946 at All Saints Episcopal Church. They lived in North Platte, Neb., briefly then moved to Cheyenne where they operated a radio repair shop. In 1949 they moved to Texas and ten years later started their own business, Walley Electronics Company, for which she was office manager.

Survivors include her husband, Lesley Walley of Beaumont, a son, John Walley of Fullerton, Calif., two daughters: Marcene Woodruff of Provo, Utah, Cheryl Smith of Port Alexander, Alaska, her mother, Violet Dannar of Redding, Calif., a brother, Bill Dannar of Wheatland, a sister, Velma June Brake of Redding, Calif., 11 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her father and by a twin sister, Viola Mae.

A memorial in her name has been established to the new Dialysis Unit at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
