

# Barney Washburn <sup>1979</sup>

Bernard Cecil Washburn, Wheatland area resident for 50 years, died Friday, Nov. 9, 1979. Funeral services were held

Tuesday, Nov. 13, 1979, at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Rev. C. W. Livers officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
