

ALICE M. WATSON 1983

Services for Alice M. Watson, 83, who died in the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing, June 2, were held Tuesday at the Wheatland Cemetery, with Rev. Ken Saunders officiating.

Alice Watson was born in Alliance, Neb., April 17, 1888, the daughter of Asa and Lillian Parrish Willey. She moved with her family to Brush, Colo., where she attended school and then moved to Montrose, Colo., where she graduated from high school. She and J. Frank Watson were married in 1912 in Montrose and then moved to Wheatland where they owned an implement dealership. Mr. Watson died in 1945 and Alice remained in Wheatland until her death. She was a member of the Rebecca Lodge and the United Methodist Church.

Mrs. Watson is survived by a sister, Neffe Rademacher, of Billings, Mont. Besides her husband she was preceded in death by three sisters and three brothers and by several nieces and nephews.
