Services for George Eldon Weaver, 70, were held Thursday, Sept. 14, at the United Methodist Church in Wheatland, Wyo. with Rev. Les Ludlam officiating.

Mr. Weaver died Tuesday, Sept. 12, 2000 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.
