

WEBER, JOSEPH F.

July 22, 1852-September 16, 1918

J.F. Weber, aged 57 years, was found dead in his bed Monday morning at the home of his son near Fort Laramie. Dr. Corry, the coroner, was called from Chugwater, and held an inquest, at which it was decided that death had resulted from apoplexy. Mr. Weber and family came to Wyoming from Oklahoma some time ago and were engaged in dry farming, making a marked success. He was an apparently strong and vigorous man and his death comes as a great surprise to all acquaintances. The body is in charge of Undertaker Longwith and funeral arrangements will be made as soon as relatives are heard from.
