

WEIGART, TENA MYRTLE BELLIS

August 10, 1886-January 13, 1931

Wheatland people were deeply shocked Tuesday when news was received that Mrs. Clarence Weigart had passed away at about 4 o'clock in the afternoon. While relatives and close friends knew her condition was extremely critical and that little hope was held for her recovery, the end shrouded the town in deep sorrow.

Mrs. Weigart had been ill for some time but serious complications set in about ten days ago and from that time on little hope was held for her recovery. Death was due to peritonitis.

Tena Myrtle Bellis was born in Worth County, Mo., August 10th, 1886 and passed away in Wheatland January 13th, 1931.

On February 28, 1912, she was united in marriage to Clarence Weigart at Grant City, Mo. To this union was born one daughter, Darlene, who survives her mother. She became a Christian at the age of 18 years and joined the Christian church at Grant City.

February 3, 1919 the family moved to Wheatland where they have since made their home.

Besides being survived by her husband and daughter, she leaves to mourn her loss her parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. Bellis, three brothers, Fred Bellis, W.B. Bellis and H.B. Bellis. She is preceded in death by a brother and sister, who died when she was just a few weeks old.

Funeral services were held from the Wheatland Christian church this afternoon, Thursday, at 2 o'clock Cecil V. Smith pastor of the church, preaching the funeral sermon. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson Mortuary in charge.
