

WERNER, DOROTHY MARGARET GLINES

March 14, 1914-August 8, 1958

The Wheatland community was greatly saddened by the death of Mrs. Sidney Werner who passed away August 8, 1958, at her home following a long illness.

Dorothy Margaret Werner was born in North Platte, Nebraska, March 14, 1914, the daughter of Eastman and Margaret Walker Glines. She received her early education in the public schools of North Platte and was a graduate of Nebraska Wesleyan University at Lincoln. She also attended the University of Wyoming. She was united in marriage May 27, 1938 to Sidney C. Werner in North Platte, Nebr. and to this union was born one daughter, Margaret.

Mrs. Werner had made her home in Wheatland the past 12 years and had taught in the Wheatland Junior High School nine of those years. Prior to coming to Wheatland, she had taught high school in Imperial, Nebraska; Otis, Colorado; and Holyoke, Colorado.

She was a member of the Wheatland Educational Association, Wyoming Educational Association, and the National Educational Association, and affiliated with the Methodist church.

Besides her husband and daughter, she is survived by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Eastman Glines of North Platte, Nebraska; one brother, Russell Glines of Ogallala, Nebraska; and one sister, Mrs. Eddie Aho of Seattle, Washington.

Rev. B.B. Byus officiated at the funeral services held in the Methodist Church at 11:00 a.m. and interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
