Services for Jessie I. Whitmore, 84, who died Jan. 15, 1983 in Cheyenne, were held Tuesday, Jan. 18 at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Eugene Rowbotham of Cheyenne officiating.

Jessie Whitmore was born Feb. 5, 1898 in Missouri, the daughter of William and Abiah Driver Moore. Born, raised and educated in Missouri, she met and married John B. Molletti in Peoria, Ill., in 1914.

The couple moved to Colorado in 1918, came to Wyoming in 1943 and then moved back and forth between Wyoming and Colorado until 1949 when she moved to Wyoming permanently.

She married James Whitmore in 1946 in Longmont, Colo. She owned and operated restaurants in Wheatland. She was a member of the V.F.W. Auxiliary and the American Legion Auxiliary of Cheyenne.

Survivors include three daughters, Blanche M. Ehlert of Longmont, Mary Higdeman of Wheatland and Ilene Horton of Cheyenne; and a brother, John Moore of Indiana. She is also survived by nine grandchildren, 20 great-grandchildren and 3 great-great-grandchildren.
