

WHITTAKER, EARL ALFRED

1934-November 16, 1942

After months of confinement in the hospital where he was being treated for burns suffered May 20 when his clothes caught fire, Earl Alfred Whittaker, aged eight, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred W. Whittaker, died at one p.m. Monday, November 16.

Surviving him are his parents and three brothers, Donald, Howard and Richard, and five half-brothers and four half-sisters: Fred Whittaker, Sterling, Colo.; Charles A. of Glasgow, Montana; Ralph B. of Wheatland; Kenneth J. of Greeley and Harold of Ft. Sill, Oklahoma; Mrs. Grace Lawless of Salem, Oregon; Louise of LaGrande, Oregon; Mrs. Joseph Collins, Fort Sill; and Eunice Fields of Wheatland.

Services were held at two o'clock Thursday afternoon from the Watson-Dennis chapel, with H.I. Maley in charge. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
