

WHITTAKER, LOREN  
October 22, 1908-December 24, 1949

The funeral service for Loren "Smokey" Whittaker was held Tuesday afternoon at the Schrader chapel with the Rev. Howard A. Rice in charge. Burial took place in the Wheatland cemetery with military honors given at the graveside.

Whittaker died Saturday in Cheyenne at the Veteran's hospital following a brief illness.

A veteran of World War II, he was born October 22, 1908 in Wheatland. His home had recently been at Rawlins although he had done ranch work and landscape gardening at Los Gatos, Calif.

His survivors include one sister, Miss Vera Whittaker of Rawlins, and four brothers, Virgil Whittaker of Los Gatos, Calif., Coll Whittaker of Rock River, Frank Whittaker of Rawlins and Ed Whittaker of Boise, Ida.
