

WIGGAM, NETTIE MARY LOVELESS

October 18, 1891-October 3, 1944

Funeral services will be held Saturday at 2 p.m. in the Schrader chapel for Mrs. R.A. Wiggam, 53, who died of a sudden heart attack at her home Tuesday, October 3. The Rev. D.F. Chaffin of the Assembly of God tabernacle will officiate and burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery.

Nettie Mary Loveless was born October 18, 1891 in Knox county, Nebr. She was united in marriage to R.A. Wiggam in Sedgwick, Colo. on May 20, 1913 and to this union five sons and one daughter were born. They moved from Ovid, Colo. to Wheatland in 1930, where they had since made their home. Mrs. Wiggam was affiliated with the Assembly of God tabernacle.

Besides her husband, she is survived by four sons, Ira E. of the coast guard, Russell W. serving with the army in Alaska, Delbert D. of the navy, and Robert W. who resides in Albany, Calif.; three sisters, Mrs. Cora Burns and Mrs. Arvilla Connelly of Ovid, Colo., and Mrs. Katie Bare of Wellwood, Nebr.; and one brother, Perry Loveless of Richland, Nebr. She was preceded in death by a son, Billy Max, who was killed in action in France June 14, 1944 and a daughter. All the survivors are expected to be present for the services.
