

Chas. Wightman Dies After An Extended Illness

Charles A. Wightman, 69, succumbed to an extended illness on Thursday, September 9, 1971 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

A resident of Wheatland for most of his life, Mr. Wightman worked for several years in the water department for the city, retiring in 1961. He was born in Wheatland on March 27, 1902.
