

WILDE, MARY A. CAMPBELL  
August 29, 1858-September 25, 1897

The community was shocked to learn Saturday evening of the death of Mrs. Anthony Wilde, which occurred at the home of the family, on the Laramie, at 9:10 p.m. Mrs. Wilde had been suffering for some time from heart disease, the trouble dating back a number of years. For a few days prior to her death, the trouble appeared in an aggravated form, but it was known by the friends of the deceased that a dangerous condition had been reached. The deceased was laid to rest Monday in the Wheatland cemetery. A number of relatives and friends accompanied the remains to the grave, nearly all the older residents of the Laramie river were numbered in the cortege.

Mary A. Campbell was born in St. Louis August 29, 1858, she being 39 years of age at the time of her death. Besides the children and husband, the deceased's mother and two brothers, Mrs. Margaret Campbell, Dr. J. Campbell and Mr. Joseph Campbell are living, their home being Ward, Colo. Mrs. Wilde was a lady of a sunny, kindly disposition and besides the immediate family relatives, there are innumerable friends who grieve her death.
