

WILLIAMS, PAUL A.
May 5, 1887-May 14, 1961

Paul A. Williams was born May 5, 1887 in Farmers, Ind., and passed away in Platte County Memorial Hospital, Wheatland, May 14, 1961, at the age of 74. He was a retired railroad earman, having worked for the Union Pacific for 10 years. Mr. Williams homesteaded in the Big Horn Basin in 1918, living in Laramie 12 ½ years and in Wheatland the past five years.

He was affiliated with the Methodist church, being a charter member in Denver, Colo. And in Wyoming. He had also been a member of the Odd Fellows Lodge for 52 years.
