

WILSON, CHERYL ANN
June 2, 1944-September 28, 1958

Cheryl Ann Wilson, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Dale L. Wilson, was killed September 28, 1958 in an automobile accident 2.6 miles west of Chugwater, about 5:15 p.m.

Mrs. R.E. Rogers, 36, of Chugwater, driver of the 1953 Nash, received bruises and cuts on her leg. Her daughter, Janet, 14, also a passenger, received facial cuts and bruises.

The car left the ruts of the graveled road, went into the barrow pit on the right and turned over 1 ¼ times, traveling 108 feet.

The fourteen year old girl is the tenth traffic victim for Platte county in 1958. This is the same number of traffic victims as in 1957, with three months left to go in this year.

Funeral services were conducted for Cheryl Ann Wilson, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Dale L. Wilson of Chugwater, from the Chugwater auditorium at 10 a.m. Wednesday, October 1.

Cheryl was born June 2, 1944, at Van Nuys, Calif., and had made her home with her parents in Chugwater for two and one-half years.

She is survived by her parents and one sister, Glenda Sue, of Chugwater.

Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with pallbearers being Darrel Mecklinberg, Frank Cushatt, Elmer Beaver, Gary Miller, Clayton Fuller and Gary Larson.
