Dolph "Buster" Wilson

Dolph "Buster" Farr Wilson, life-time area resident, passed away Friday, May 18, 1979.

Buster Wilson was born May 29, 1906 on the family homestead in Platte County, the son of Charles and Mildred Farr Wilson. He attended area country schools and worked with his dad on the family ranch prior to entering the US Army where he served in England during WW II.

After his discharge from the military, he came back to the area and worked on various ranching operations with his family. Buster operated a business in connection with Adams & Western Store here

in Wheatland.

He is survived by one brother, David Wilson of Boulder, Wyo. and one sister, Mildred Rietz, of Wauseon, Ohio. He was preceded in death by six brothers and one sister as well as his parents.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, May 22, 1979, at 2 p.m. at the United Methodist Church in Wheatland with the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
