## WILSON, JAMES P. September 16, 1896-November 3, 1918

A message was received Saturday conveying the message that James Wilson had died of pneumonia at Camp McArthur, Texas, on Friday. He was the son of Charles Wilson, a well-known ranchman on the North Laramie. The young man was called into service on Oct. 24<sup>th</sup>, and had scarcely reached camp when he was stricken with the prevailing epidemic and death soon followed. The body was shipped back to Wheatland for burial.
