

WOODS, REBECCA ARMSTRONG  
November 2, 1838-January, 1929

Funeral services were held for Mrs. Rebecca Armstrong Woods at the Chapel of the Watson Mortuary, Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. Robt. Hoffman of the Congregational church preached the funeral oration and the singing was rendered by a mixed quartet composed of Mrs. Chas. W. Hahn, Mrs. O.O. Natwick, Robert Trenholm, and T.B. Hunton. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson Mortuary in charge of arrangements.

Rebecca Armstrong was born at Chamberberg, Penn. November 2. She was married to N. Wilson Woods in 1862 and they came to Wyoming in 1871. In 1899, they moved to the Uva ranching district and lived on their ranch on the North Laramie for a number of years. Mr. Woods preceded in death several years and she was buried beside her husband. She is survived by three children, Mrs. Carroll Smith, of Hot Springs, S.D., James Woods of Butte, Mont., and Chas. Woods of Cheyenne; eight grandchildren and three great grandchildren and many friends and other relatives. She was united with the Presbyterian church at the age of 12 years and has been a member ever since.

The husband of Mrs. Woods was the first person to be buried in the Wheatland cemetery.
