

Robert George Woolsey

November 21, 1970 – August 24, 2006

A Funeral service for Robert George Woolsey, 35, was conducted at 2 p.m., Tuesday, Aug. 29 at the First Christian Church in Wheatland, with Pastor Andy Gudahl officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

He died Thursday, Aug. 24, 2006, at his home near Wheatland.

Robert was born Nov. 21, 1970, the son of Alice Marie (Smith) and George Woolsey, Jr. He was reared and educated in the Wheatland area, graduating from Wheatland High School. He worked as a farm and ranch hand for Juan Reyes and Bob Sinnard; at the Wagonhound Ranch at Douglas, and for True Ranches at Wheatland for over 10 years. Robert married the love of his life, Christina Marie "Tina" Hermann on Jan. 13, 1996, in Wheatland. Robert was a "modern day mountain man" in every way. He enjoyed hunting, trapping, horn hunting, guns, and being at the ranch at Garrett. He enjoyed his dirt bike when he was little and his 4-wheeler later on. He fought fires, read 4-wheel and off-road magazines, enjoyed roping, and loved playing with his four nephews.
