

WYMAN, MARY  
May 27, 1848-April 29, 1929

The many friends of Mrs. Mary Wyman were grieved to learn of her death at her home in Uva on Monday, April 29<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Wyman was born May 27<sup>th</sup>, 1848 and was 80 years old at the time of her death. She came to Wyoming in 1886 and has been a resident of the Uva district the past 20 years. Her husband, Chas. H. Wyman, preceded her in death in 1910. Mrs. Wyman was well known to almost everyone in Platte county and was one of its most respected citizens. She is survived by six children, they being Mrs. Harry Mills of Dubois, Wyo., Eugene Wyman of Uva, Mrs. Luella Skarratt of Bellflower, Calif., Mrs. Ed Robinson of Uva, Mrs. Walter Robinson of Laramie, and Mrs. John McFarlane of Uva. All of the children were present at the funeral with the exception of Mrs. Skarratt. She is also survived by 26 grandchildren and 17 great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held from the local Congregational church Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock with Rev. Marion Morris of Dwyer preaching the funeral oration and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson Mortuary in charge of arrangements.
